

CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CONTRACTOR AND THE PARTNER

This contract shall govern relations between:

Dansk Frisør & Kosmetiker Forbund, Lersø Parkalle 21, DK-2100 Copenhagen, hereinafter named "the Contractor" represented by Poul MONGGAARD

on the one hand and on the other hand:

Coiffure EU, Gooierserf 400, NL-1276 KT, Huizen, hereafter named" the Partner", represented by Robert VOS

which have agreed as follows:

The Partner declares to participating in the project "**EQF-Hair - Making non formal education fit into NQF using the EQF as a translating tools to support the recognition of vocational non formal education: The example of the European Hairdressing Certification**" led by the Dansk Frisør & Kosmetiker Forbund, presented under the call for proposal DG EAC/20/2007.

Duration of the project:


The project has a duration of 18 months. It starts 01.02.2008 and ends on 01.09.09. The period of eligibility of the costs starts on 01.02.2008 and ends on 01.09.09.

Obligation of the Partner:

The Partner shall undertake to take all the steps necessary to prepare for, perform and correctly manage the work programme set up in this contract in accordance with the objectives of the project.

In the context of this project, my organisation will notably:

- Participate actively in **work package 1: Assess and test the European Hairdressing Certificate (Level B) against the EQF**
- Lead the **work package 3: Analysis and Recommendations - Putting forward the outlines of the Guide**
- Participate actively in **work package 5: General Coordination and Management of the Project**
- participate in meetings, take care of the technical organisation of meetings
- provide expertise on national or sectoral matters



My organisation will provide the project leader with its expertise, experts' and staff working time and technical resources, whenever required. The repartition of the final budget and its deriving financial obligations will be detailed in the partnership agreement to be signed between the project leader and our organisation after the project would be accepted by the European Commission.

Cost of the project:

The total eligible costs of the project for the contractual period referred to by the Agreement number *137946-LLP-2007-DK-KA1EQF* is **295.928 Euro**.

The maximum grant proposal for award is **171.638 Euro**. This is a funding of 58%.

Financing

The total expenditure to be committed by the Partner for the period covered by this contract is estimated at **13.988 Euro**.

The European Commission contribution for the Partner shall be a maximum amount of **8.113 Euro**.

Co-financing

The Partners financial contribution to the project amounts to **5.875 Euro**.

Payments

The Contractor commits himself to carrying out payments relating to the subject matter of this contract to the Partner according to the achievement of the tasks and presentation of financial documents and according to the following schedule:

1st payment	= 40 % of requested euros at receipt of signed contract
2nd payment	= 30 % of requested euros at accept of interim report approx. February 2009
Final payment	= 30 % of requested euros at acceptance by European Commission of final report approx. September 2009

All payments shall be regarded as advances pending explicit approval by the European Commission of the final report, the corresponding cost statement and the equality of the results of the project.



Termination of the contract

The Contractor may terminate the contract if the Partner has inadequately discharged or failed to discharge any of the contractual obligations, insofar as this is not due to *force majeure*, after notification of the Partner by registered letter has remained without effect for one month.



The Partner shall immediately notify the Contractor, supplying all relevant information, of any event likely to prejudice the performance of this contract.


